What is a Joy FM Street Team?

The Joy FM Network covers a significant amount of population. Joy FM has a small staff, with the main network staff being located in Winston-Salem, NC and is unable to be at many concerts or events due to distance and time. A “street team” would be 2 – 3 volunteers from a particular area that would attend events and concerts for Joy FM, representing Joy FM to the public.

What would a Joy FM street team specifically do?

- Attend local concerts
 - Set up booth / table at concert
 - Wear Joy FM t-shirts to local concerts / events
 - Invite listeners to sign up for Email newsletter and join mailing list
 - On-site giveaways and contests
- Attend local fairs, festivals and parades as Joy FM
- Call in to the Morning Show with live updates on concerts, events and etc.
- Help recruit Christian businesses to support Joy FM
- During collection drives (such as back to school supply drives and Christmas toy drives) the street team could help us be in areas that we normally don't get to

Communication

- We plan a monthly Street Team conference call so Joy FM can be seen at multiple events
- We will also include the Street Team on important emails and upcoming station promotions

Perks/benefits of being a Street Team member:

- Free concert tickets!
- Free Joy FM product
- Being a vital part of Joy FM's team
- Help serve Christ by sharing his love with people

Terms of volunteer agreement (the fine print):

- As a Street Team member, you are serving strictly as a non-employee volunteer of Joy FM
- Non-employees are not permitted to drive any of the station vehicles
- Non-employees volunteers will serve with the understanding that no financial compensation will be offered
- While serving as a street team member, you will be representing Joy FM and must display consistent standards of personal and moral quality.
- You may be provided with vehicle magnets displaying the Joy FM logo and colors
- Reimbursements of expenses must be approved prior to incurring such expense with Joy FM management
- In the local street team, one member may be named as “chairperson” who will coordinate the team locally and with Joy FM directly.
